

**PIASA RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB, INC. BY-LAWS (Revised) February 8, 2020**

**ARTICLE I - NAME**

THE NAME OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE PIASA RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB, INC.

**ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVE**

THE OBJECTIVE OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE THE ENCOURAGEMENT OF ORGANIZED RIFLE AND PISTOL COMPETITION AND RECREATIONAL SHOOTING AMONG THE RESIDENTS IN OUR COMMUNITY, WITH A VIEW TOWARD A BETTER KNOWLEDGE OF THE SAFE HANDLING AND PROPER CARE OF FIREARMS, AS WELL AS IMPROVED MARKSMANSHIP. IT SHALL BE OUR FURTHER OBJECTIVE TO FURTHER THE DEVELOPMENT OF THOSE CHARACTERISTICS OF HONESTY, GOOD FELLOWSHIP, SELF-DISCIPLINE, TEAM PLAY AND SELF-RELIANCE WHICH ARE THE ESSENTIALS OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AND THE FOUNDATION OF TRUE PATRIOTISM.

**ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP**

**(A) SENIOR**

ANY NATURAL PERSON, 21 YEAR OF AGE OR OVER, WHO IS AN NRA MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OR HAS APPLICATION ON FILE TO BECOME AN NRA MEMBER MAY UPON SUBMITTAL OF A COMPLETED MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION BECOME A MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT AT ANY MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION AND ON THE PAYMENT OF THE USUAL FEES. THE PETITIONING MEMBER MUST BE PRESENT AT A REGULAR MEETING, ANNUAL MEETING OR EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING BEFORE BEING ACCEPTED INTO THE ORGANIZATION.

**(1) ADULT MEMBERSHIP**

A MEMBER WHO ACCEPTS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF PLACING HIS NAME ON THE WORK ROSTER AND ABIDES BY THE RULES OF THE CLUB.

**(2) ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP**

A MEMBER WHO IS A SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT OF AND RESIDING WITH AN ADULT MEMBER. SUCH MEMBERSHIP WILL BE LIMITED TO CLUB APPROVED ACTIVITIES AND WILL NOT INCLUDE THE RIGHT TO VOTE OR THE UNSUPERVISED USE OF THE RANGE.

**(3) SENIOR CITIZEN MEMBERSHIP**

A MEMBER WHO HAS ATTAINED THE AGE OF 60 YEARS. VALID PROOF OF AGE MUST BE SHOWN.

**(4) LIFE MEMBERSHIP**

AN HONORARY MEMBERSHIP WITH FULL CLUB PRIVILEGES AWARDED TO A MEMBER WHO HAS COMPLETED 10 OR MORE YEARS OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE. THIS MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE AWARDED UPON UNANIMOUS APPROVAL OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD. THIS MEMBERSHIP STATUS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM PAYMENT OF DUES AND WORK OBLIGATION.

**(5) PIASA ACTIVITIES**

A PERSON MUST BE A MEMBER OR A HAVE A MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION ON FILE WITH A PIASA OFFICER, TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY PIASA ACTIVITY.

**(B) JUNIOR**

ANY INDIVIDUAL, 9 YEARS THROUGH 20 YEARS OF AGE, INCLUSIVE, MAY BECOME A JUNIOR MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION ON VOTE OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND PAYMENT OF ANNUAL FEES. SUCH MEMBERSHIP WILL BE LIMITED TO CLUB APPROVED JUNIOR ACTIVITIES AND WILL NOT INCLUDE THE RIGHT TO VOTE OR THE UNSUPERVISED USE OF THE RANGE. JUNIOR MEMBERS SHALL BE EXTENDED THE PRIVILEGE OF CLUB TEAM SHOOTING WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD

ARTICLE IV - DUES AND FEES

- (A) THE ANNUAL DUES AND INITIATION FEES SHALL BE SET IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE VII (G) WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTION OF:  
  
"ASSOCIATE", "SENIOR CITIZEN" AND "JUNIOR" WITH SENIOR SHOOTING TEAM APPROVAL", DUES SHALL BE SET AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD ACCORDING TO ARTICLE VII (G).
- (B) ANNUAL DUES SHALL BE PAYABLE IN ADVANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1ST AND ENDING JUNE 30TH.
- (C) A MEMBER SHALL BE CONSIDERED IN ARREARS IF PAYMENT OF DUES HAS NOT BEEN MADE PRIOR TO THE AUGUST MEETING. REINSTATEMENT, AFTER 1 DECEMBER OF THE CURRENT YEAR, WILL FOLLOW THE PROCEDURE OUTLINED IN ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP, AND ARTICLE IV.
- (D) THE COMBINATION TO THE RANGE SHALL BE CHANGED ON THE NIGHT OF THE JUNE MEETING AND A NEW CODE WILL BE ISSUED TO THE MEMBER UPON PAYMENT OF HIS DUES.

ARTICLE V - MEETINGS

(A) **ANNUAL MEETING**

THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION SHALL COMMENCE AT 7:30 P.M. ON THE THIRD THURSDAY OF APRIL OF EACH YEAR. NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE POSTED ON THE NEWSLETTER OF THE PREVIOUS MONTH. THE OFFICERS ARE TO BE ELECTED AT THIS MEETING AND WILL ASSUME THEIR OFFICES AT THE MAY REGULAR MEETING.

A REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION FOR TRANSACTION OF ORDINARY BUSINESS SHALL BE HELD ONCE A MONTH. THE THIRD THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH AT 7:30 P.M. WILL BE THE REGULAR MEETING DATE AND TIME UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTIFIED.

(B) **SPECIAL MEETING**

A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION MAY BE HELD AT ANY TIME UPON THE CALL OF THE PRESIDENT OR UPON THE CALL OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OR UPON DEMAND. NOTICE OF THE TIME, PLACE AND OBJECTIVE OF ANY SPECIAL MEETING SHALL BE GIVEN TO ALL OFFICERS AND MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING. THE PLACE OF THE SPECIAL MEETING SHALL BE FIXED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.

- (C) FIFTY ONE PERCENT OF THE MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATION PRESENT WHO ARE ENTITLED TO VOTE SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM AT ANY MEETING. A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE QUORUM SHALL BE REQUIRED TO CARRY ANY MOTION. IN THE EVENT THERE IS NOT A QUORUM PRESENT AT ANY STATED MEETING, THE EXECUTIVE BOARD IS EMPOWERED TO ACT FOR THE MEMBERSHIP IN ALL MATTERS OF BUSINESS. IN ADDITION TO THE POSSIBLE MOTION OF MEMBERS PRESENT, A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD SHALL BE REQUIRED TO CARRY ANY MOTION.

- (D) ANY DEFEATED MOTION OR BY-LAW AMENDMENT SHALL NOT BE RECONSIDERED DURING THE SUBSEQUENT SIX (6) MONTH PERIOD.

ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

- (A) THE OFFICERS OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE A PRESIDENT, SECRETARY,

TREASURER, 1ST DIRECTOR, 2ND DIRECTOR, AND 3RD DIRECTOR WHO ACTING TOGETHER SHALL CONSTITUTE THE EXECUTIVE BOARD. PREREQUISITE FOR OFFICERS SHALL BE:

A) THEY MUST BE AN ADULT OR SENIOR CITIZEN MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING FOR A MINIMUM OF THREE YEARS PRIOR TO THEIR NOMINATION AND

B) THEY HAVE ATTENDED A MINIMUM OF FIVE MEETINGS IN THE PREVIOUS 12 MONTHS PRIOR TO THEIR NOMINATION.

THEY SHALL BE ELECTED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING PRESENT AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION. THEY SHALL HOLD OFFICE FOR TWO YEARS OR UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSORS ARE ELECTED.

THE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, AND 2ND DIRECTOR SHALL BE ELECTED DURING ODD CALENDAR YEARS. THE TREASURER, 1ST DIRECTOR, AND 3RD DIRECTOR SHALL BE ELECTED DURING EVEN CALENDAR YEARS. ALL OFFICERS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM DUES DURING THEIR TERM IN OFFICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION F OF THIS SECTION BELOW.

- (B) THE EXECUTIVE BOARD SHALL HAVE GENERAL SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF ALL THE ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANIZATION.
- (C) MEETINGS OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD SHALL BE HELD REGULARLY AT SUCH TIME AND PLACE AS THE BOARD MAY DETERMINE. SPECIAL MEETINGS MAY BE HELD AT ANY TIME ON THE CALL OF THE PRESIDENT OR ON DEMAND IN WRITING, TO THE SECRETARY, BY THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.
- (D) FOUR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL CONSTITUTE A QUORUM.
- (E) A VACANCY IN THE EXECUTIVE BOARD MAY BE FILLED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AFTER: A) NOTICE OF SUCH VACANCY IS PUBLISHED IN THE NEXT MONTHLY NEWSLETTER, AND, B) THE BOARD NOTIFIED THE MEMBERSHIP OF THEIR SELECTION AT THE NEXT REGULAR MEETING. HOWEVER, IF MORE THAN ONE VACANCY EXISTS, A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION SHALL BE CALLED AND NEW OFFICERS SHALL BE ELECTED TO FILL THE VACANCIES UNTIL THE DATE OF THE NEXT ANNUAL MEETING AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (A) ABOVE.
- (F) A MEMBER WHO TAKES OFFICE BETWEEN ELECTIONS SHALL BE REIMBURSED ON A PRO-RATED BASIS FOR THEIR PREPAID DUES. BOARD MEMBERS WHO EXIT THEIR OFFICE PRIOR TO SERVING THEIR FULL TERM SHALL PAY DUES ON A PRO-RATED BASIS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

#### ARTICLE VII - DUTIES OF OFFICERS

- (A) **PRESIDENT**  
THE PRESIDENT SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL MEETINGS OF THE ORGANIZATION AND OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD. HE SHALL BE A MEMBER EX-OFFICIO OF ALL REGULAR AND SPECIAL COMMITTEES AND SHALL PERFORM ALL SUCH DUTIES AS USUALLY PERTAIN TO HIS OFFICE.
- (B) **1ST DIRECTOR**  
THE 1ST DIRECTOR SHALL PERFORM THE DUTIES OF THE PRESIDENT IN HIS ABSENCE OR AT HIS REQUEST.
- (C) **SECRETARY**  
THE SECRETARY SHALL CONDUCT ALL OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE PERTAINING TO THE PROPER PREPARATION AND FORWARDING OF ALL REPORTS REQUIRED OF THE ORGANIZATION BY THE NRA HEADQUARTERS, STATE OF ILLINOIS, AND/OR ANY OTHER

REQUIRED REPORTING AGENCY. HE SHALL NOTIFY THE MEMBERS AND THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF ALL MEETINGS AS REQUIRED IN ARTICLE V. HE SHALL KEEP MINUTES OF ALL MEETINGS OF THE ORGANIZATION AND HAVE THE CUSTODY OF THE BOOKS AND PAPERS OF THE CLUB. ALL APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE CLUB SHALL BE MADE TO THE SECRETARY. HE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COLLECTION OF ALL FEES AND DUES AND SHALL REMIT THE SAME TO THE TREASURER, TAKING HIS PROPER RECEIPT THEREFORE.

(D) **TREASURER**

THE TREASURER SHALL HAVE CHARGE OF ALL FUNDS OF THE ORGANIZATION. THE TREASURER SHALL KEEP AN ACCURATE ACCOUNT OF ALL HIS TRANSACTIONS AND READ A DETAILED REPORT WITH VOUCHERS AT ALL BUSINESS MEETINGS OF THE ORGANIZATION. THE TREASURER SHALL RENDER A DETAILED REPORT WITH VOUCHERS AT ANY MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD WHEN REQUESTED. AN ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE PREVIOUS FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE RENDERED AT THE JULY MEETING. COPIES OF THIS REPORT SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR EACH MEMBER PRESENT.

(E) **2ND DIRECTOR**

THE 2ND DIRECTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CLUB'S RANGE. HE MAY SCHEDULE WORK PARTIES. HE SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO APPOINT ASSISTANCE. HE SHALL CO-WORK WITH 3<sup>rd</sup> DIRECTOR.

(F) **3RD DIRECTOR**

THE 3RD DIRECTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE CLUB'S RANGE. HE MAY SCHEDULE WORK PARTIES. HE SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO APPOINT ASSISTANCE. HE SHALL CO-WORK WITH 2<sup>ND</sup> DIRECTOR.

(G) THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND ELECTED SUCCESSORS SHALL MEET, SOMETIME AFTER THE ELECTIONS IN APRIL AND BEFORE THE MAY MEETING, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREPARING THE PROPOSED BUDGET AND ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES AND ESTABLISHING THE DUES AND FEES FOR THE SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR. SUFFICIENT COPIES OF THIS DATA, IN READABLE FORMAT, SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR EACH MEMBER PRESENT AT THE MAY MEETING. THIS DATA SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE MEMBERSHIP PRESENT AND UPON APPROVAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE V (D), SHALL BECOME BINDING UPON THE MEMBERSHIP OF THIS CLUB.

ARTICLE VIII - SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION

(A) ANY OFFICER MAY BE REMOVED BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING PRESENT AT ANY SPECIAL MEETING CALLED FOR THIS PURPOSE. NO VOTE ON SUSPENSION OR REMOVAL MAY BE TAKEN UNLESS AT LEAST FIFTEEN DAYS NOTICE IN WRITING SHALL HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO THE OFFICER OF THE REASONS FOR HIS REMOVAL AND OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE SPECIAL MEETING AT WHICH THE BALLOT ON HIS REMOVAL IS TO BE TAKEN. AT SUCH SPECIAL MEETING THE OFFICER SHALL BE GIVEN A FULL HEARING.

(B) ANY MEMBER MAY BE SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED FROM THE ORGANIZATION FOR ANY CAUSE DEEMED SUFFICIENT BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD BY A TWO-THIRDS AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD PRESENT AT ANY REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETINGS. NO VOTE ON SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION MAY BE TAKEN UNLESS AT LEAST FIFTEEN DAYS NOTICE IN WRITING SHALL HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO THE MEMBER OF THE CHARGE REFERRED AND OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AT WHICH SUCH CHARGES WILL BE CONSIDERED. AT SUCH MEETING THE MEMBER UNDER CHARGES WILL BE ACCORDED A FULL HEARING.

(C) CHARGES AGAINST ANY OFFICER OR MEMBER MAY BE REFERRED BY ANY MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING. THEY SHALL BE IN WRITING, CLEARLY STATING THE FACTS RELIED UPON AND ACCOMPANIED BY ALL AFFIDAVITS AND EXHIBITS WHICH ARE TO BE USED IN

THEIR SUPPORT. SUCH CHARGES SHALL BE FILED WITH THE SECRETARY, WHO SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE PRESIDENT. THE PRESIDENT WILL CALL A MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD TO HEAR THE CHARGES. THE SECRETARY WILL GIVE AT LEAST FIFTEEN DAYS NOTICE OF THE MEETING TO EACH MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AND TO THE ACCUSER AND TO THE ACCUSED, WHICH NOTICE SHALL BE IN WRITING AND WILL INCLUDE A TRUE COPY OF THE CHARGES AND OF THE SUPPORTING AFFIDAVITS AND EXHIBITS.

- (D) ANY MEMBER SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD MAY APPEAL TO THE FULL MEMBERSHIP OF THE ORGANIZATION. SUCH APPEAL SHALL BE MADE TO THE SECRETARY IN WRITING WHO WILL NOTIFY THE PRESIDENT. THE PRESIDENT WILL CALL A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ORGANIZATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACTING ON THE APPEAL. THE SECRETARY SHALL GIVE AT LEAST FIFTEEN DAYS NOTICE IN WRITING TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATION IN GOOD STANDING, STATING THE DATE, TIME, PLACE AND REASON FOR SUCH SPECIAL MEETING. AT THE MEETING OF THE FULL CLUB, THE SECRETARY WILL READ THE ORIGINAL CHARGES, THE SUPPORTING AFFIDAVITS, AND WILL READ OR DISPLAY THE ACCOMPANYING EXHIBITS, AND WILL READ THE MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD AT WHICH THE CHARGES WERE HEARD AND ACTION TAKEN. A FULL HEARING WILL BE GIVEN THE ACCUSER AND THE ACCUSED. A VOTE WILL BE TAKEN BY BALLOT OF THE MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING PRESENT AND A TWO-THIRDS VOTE SHALL BE REQUIRED TO REVERSE THE ACTION OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.
- (E) ANY OFFICIAL OR MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION WHO HAS BEEN SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED BY THE NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION SHALL AUTOMATICALLY STAND SUSPENDED OR EXPELLED FROM THIS ORGANIZATION IMMEDIATELY UPON RECEIPT OF OFFICIAL NOTICE BY THE NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION.

#### ARTICLE IX - MATCH RULES

ALL RIFLE AND REVOLVER OR PISTOL COMPETITIONS HELD BY THE CLUB WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE NRA OR THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR THE PROMOTION OF RIFLE PRACTICE AND THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.

#### ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS

ANY AMENDMENT TO THESE BY-LAWS WILL BE VOTED UPON AT ANY MEETING OF THE CLUB AFTER HAVING BEEN SENT TO EACH MEMBER AT LEAST TEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE MEETING. UPON APPROVAL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE V (D), THE AMENDMENT WILL BE INCORPORATED IN THE ORGANIZATION BY-LAWS.

#### ARTICLE XI - RANGE RULES

- (1) EAR PROTECTION MUST BE WORN.
- (2) SAFETY GLASSES MUST BE WORN.
- (3) ALL MEMBERS SHALL, WHILE USING CLUB FACILITIES MUST HAVE PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP.
- (4) NO UNAUTHORIZED AMMUNITION IS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.  
SEE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND SAFETY RULES FOR UNAUTHORIZED AMMUNITION.
- (5) MID-RANGE TARGET LOADS ONLY.
- (6) NO FIRING SHALL BE DONE EXCEPT IN THE PRESCRIBED TARGET BAYS.
- (7) NO INTOXICATING BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED.
- (8) NO SMOKING ON THE RANGE. POSSIBILITY OF EXPLOSION
- (9) IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL MEMBERS TO CONDUCT THEIR ACTIVITIES ON THE

RANGE IN A SAFE AND ORDERLY MANNER, WITH DUE CONSIDERATION TO FELLOW CLUB MEMBERS. VIOLATIONS OF RANGE RULES SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD.

- (10) NO "QUICK DRAW", "COMBAT", FULLY AUTOMATIC FIREARMS, OR OTHER UNSAFE OR UNCONTROLLED SHOOTING IS ALLOWED. THE USE OF SHOTSHELLS IS PROHIBITED.
- (11) MEMBER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR GUESTS. GUESTS AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS ARE NOT PERMITTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER.
- (12) NO MORE THAN 5 JUNIORS PER INSTRUCTOR OR COACH ARE PERMITTED ON THE FIRING LINE AT ANY ONE TIME DURING ORGANIZED JUNIOR ACTIVITIES.
- (13) GUNS WILL NOT BE HANDLED BY ANYONE IN ANY MANNER WHILE ANYONE IS ON THE DOWNRANGE SIDE OF THE FIRING LINE.
- (14) NO SHOOTING FORWARD OF THE 50 FOOT FIRING LINE IS PERMITTED.
- (15) ONLY GUNS IN GOOD CONDITION AND WITH SAFE AMMUNITION MAY BE USED.
- (16) ALL SHOTS MUST BE FIRED THROUGH TARGETS IN BACKSTOP. FIRING AT OBJECTS ON THE FLOOR IS PROHIBITED.
- (17) NO CROSS LANE SHOOTING!
- (18) MAXIMUM NUMBER OF GUESTS AT ONE TIME IS (4) FOUR.

ARTICLE XII COMMUNICATION TO MEMBERS

COMMUNICATION TO MEMBERS IS TO BE DONE BY WHAT IS CURRENTLY SOCIALLY ACCEPTABLE. ETC. POSTAL MAIL, EMAIL OR NEWSLETTER.

AMENDMENT 1

IN THE EVENT THAT PIASA RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB INC.
